Cannon Lodge Proposal for the Amendment of Bylaws April 2018

PROPOSAL 1:

Existing Article II, Section 6 (establishing the Board of Trustees) shall be amended to read as follows:

There shall be a Board of Trustees consisting of three members, each of whom shall serve a term of three years. Each three year term shall be staggered so that one term expires each year. The duties of the Board of Trustees shall be to preserve, maintain, and improve the facilities of the lodge. The annual budget of the Board of Trustees shall be as approved annually by the membership of the Lodge. Vacancies in the board of Trustees created by death, resignation, or removal of an incumbent shall be filled ad interim by an appointment by the Worshipful Master until the next annual election of officers.

PROPOSAL 2:

Article XI shall be added to the bylaws and shall read as follows:

Section 1: Mission Statement - The Permanent Fund Committee shall be appointed by the Worshipful Master for the purposes of reviewing the permanent fund of the Lodge and providing recommendations to the membership Lodge regarding the investments.

Section 2: Permanent Fund - The Lodge shall maintain a Permanent Fund, separate and distinct from the general operating funds of the lodge, for the purposes of investment and growth. The Lodge shall not cause the principal balance of the Permanent Fund to fall below five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00). If any circumstance requiring expenditure should arise which may result in the principal balance of the fund to fall below this amount, notice shall be given to members of the Lodge by publication in the trestle board. Any such expenditure must be approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Lodge members at the next communication.

Section 3: Responsibilities - The responsibilities of the Permanent Fund are as follows:

(a) To serve as a panel of advisors charged with making recommendations to the membership of the Lodge regarding the allocation of investments and disbursements thereof. Cannon Lodge Proposal for the Amendment of Bylaws April 2018

- (b) The chairman of the committee shall serve as liaison between the membership of the Lodge and the financial institutions and financial advisors retained by the lodge.
- (c) The investments of the Permanent Fund and any transfers or disbursements thereof shall be subject to the approval of the Lodge membership.

Section 4: Organization - The Committee shall consist of three members of the Lodge in good standing, to be appointed by the Worshipful Master during the annual meeting of the Lodge. The term of each member shall be one year. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the Worshipful Master.

The Committee shall, in its January meeting or as soon as practicable, select from its membership a Chairperson by a majority vote.

Section 4: Meetings - The Permanent Fund Committee shall meet a minimum of once per quarter. Special meetings may be called by the chair of the committee, the Worshipful Master of the lodge, or a majority of the members upon timely notice to the members of the Committee.

PROPOSAL 3:

A new section shall be added to the existing Article IV (governing committees), and shall read as follows:

Article IV, Section 4: A Permanent Fund Committee for the oversight of the investments of the lodge shall be administered in accordance with Article XI.
